The editor and editorial team are responsible for reviewing submissions (accepting/rejecting) manuscripts, professional perspectives, and creative works based on the scholarship presented and the appropriateness of the work.

## **Editorial Board Members will:**

- Review 6-8 submitted manuscripts annually. Reviews will include revised versions of manuscripts
- Contribute to the journal board governance in planning and management policy and scope
- Identify topics for special issues
- Assist the editor(s) in decision-making over issues such as but not limited to:
  - Conflicting reviewer decisions on manuscripts
  - manuscript no institutional review board approval for research on human subjects or animals
  - errors in the research
  - copyright infringement
  - plagiarism
  - falsification of data or results
  - fabrication of data or results
  - failure to disclose conflict of interest
  - Promote the journal informally and through colleagues, peers, and authors and call for submissions
